Flower Exhibitions to Celebrate the Centenary Anniversary of the Founding of the Communist Party of China

The year 2021 sees the start of the 14th Five-Year Plan period and the centenary of the Communist Party of China (CPC). From May 21 to July 2, the 10th China Flower Expo, co-hosted by the National Forestry and Grassland Administration, the China Flower Association and the Shanghai Municipal People's Government, will be held in Shanghai, the birthplace of the CPC. It will be the first flowers event held on an island, in a village and in a forest. Chongming District, as the main venue of the event, will become a "flower island on the sea", where the blossoming flowers are displayed in its three zones, one exhibition center, one axis, six pavilions and six gardens to celebrate the prosperity of a stronger China. The event will showcase the splendid chapter of floriculture in the development of ecological civilization.

Yangzhou International Horticultural Exposition: To See a World in a Garden

On April 8, 2021, the International Horticultural Exposition, the first one to be hosted in the Yangtze River Delta, will be held in Yangzhou, which is hailed as the city born with the canal and the city famous with cuisine and culture. The Expo 2021 Yangzhou is, the right event to mark the centenary of the CPC. It puts focus on the integration of the expo events with post-expo functions, sustainable operation with themed exhibitions, and the exhibition industry with the cultural tourism industry. Inspired by "To see a world in a garden", the expo will utilize the gardens to draw flower enthusiasts and tourists, and culture to attract friends from afar with its main display areas featuring "one axis", "two arteries", "five centers" and "eight zones". It will engage the surrounding scenic spots and villages in this high-profile feast of international influence.

The Bamboo and Rattan Garden at Expo 2021 Yangzhou: Bamboo as a Green Construction Material

The Bamboo and Rattan Garden at Expo 2021 Yangzhou adopts the traditional landscape artistic concept and the nature-respecting landscaping techniques to fully leverage the advantages of bamboo in garden construction. The gold-colored raw bamboo is used to build a fish-shaped stadium, while modern engineering bamboo materials to build a traditional waterfront pavilion of typical Yangzhou style. Both bamboo-made buildings show the unique functional and aesthetical qualities of bamboo and rattan, which are a highlight on the picturesque venue of Expo 2021 Yangzhou.

The Bamboo and Rattan Garden at the 10th China Flower Expo: An Epitome of Bamboo and Rattan Spirit

The Bamboo and Rattan Garden, which will be a permanent facility, adopts a modern and minimalist architectural design that features a bamboo cocoon shape and an integration of modern bamboo materials and traditional bamboo bridge landscape. Bamboo and rattan weaved into the space and dimensions, as the main construction materials, have presented a park radiating with the spirit of the two plants.

Yangzhou is one of the first 24 famous historical and cultural cities approved by the State Council. Its name was first seen in The Book of Documents, a Chinese classic that has put the city among the ranks of the nine major places of the Middle Kingdom. Throughout the ages, Yangzhou has been well-known for its long history, rich resources, cultural heritage, traditional gardens and prosperous local economy. As a critical junction of both the Land Silk Road and the Maritime Silk Road, it has been committed to promoting culture and friendship to write a chapter of win-win cooperation of this new era.

The Cultural Message in Yangzhou's Urban Forest Development

Yangzhou located at the confluence of Yangtze River and Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal boasts profound cultural heritage, especially its renowned local scholars who were viewed as the offshoots of the southern academic community. It is blessed with cultural relics from the ancient times, green trees and traditional gardens, ancient trees and the Grand Canal, all of which serve as cultural carriers. By tapping the forests' functions like natural isolation, cultural connection and support, the city has built an urban space of forests, rivers and ancient sites which is culturally refreshing and environmentally friendly. It has promoted its thousand-year cultural heritage and unleashed its potential in green development.

The Art of Stone-stacking in Geyuan Garden of Yangzhou: A Little Cosmos Hidden in the Garden

The gardens of Yangzhou in the Qing Dynasty were the best of its kind, especially the art of stone-stacking. In Geyuan Garden, stones are stacked to create artificial mountains of four seasons according to the painting theories. The hollow structure and odd shapes of the stones are used for different purposes; some big stones are stacked to make peaks while groups of smaller ones are assembled to create a scene. The garden with superb integration of stone mountains and stone creatures represents the acme of stone-stacking of Yangzhou gardens. Its superb techniques can be applied to contemporary urban gardens.

Returning Fish Farming to Lake: An Ancient Fish Village Busting with New Vitality

Yanhu Village, located by the Shaobo Lake in Yangzhou, is home to 61 square kilometers of national ecological reserve. It is a century-old fishing village with deep-rooted fishing culture, such as the mysterious ritual of sacrifice before fishing, the fishing skills that have been passed down from generation to generation, and flower-shaped buns. Thanks to the South-to-North Water Diversion Project and the Jianghuai Ecological Corridor Project, all the fishermen in the village have been offered new job opportunities. By relying on the rich resources, they have made full use of the Internet, the lake and the local fishing culture to embark on the path of developing eco-tourism, becoming an exemplary case of "beautiful countryside" in Yangzhou.

Yongle Village: A Star of the Chongming Island

Yongle Village in the Chongmingmiao Town of Shanghai has both island features and southern China traditions. It has abandoned the traditional agriculture of growing wheat, oilseed rape and rice since the reform and opening up. Instead, it has been the reputed base of saffron-based industries by building a saffron planting base, a research and development center for saffron industry, a recreation and healthcare center, and a highland of traditional Chinese medicine industry. The flower itself has become a cash cow, a source of happiness for the villagers who discovered their sense of mission and path to wealth.

Meeting the Most Beautiful Alpine Lakes in the Black Forest of Germany

The Black Forest, located in southwestern Germany, is the birthplace of the Danube and Neckar rivers and the background where many fantasies from Grimm's Fairy Tales are said to happen.
