#### Qilian Mountain National Park: A Concerto of a Community of Shared Destiny

"Qilian Mountain National Park" covers 12 counties in Gansu and Qinghai. It is located in a cultural intersection where more than 20 ethnic groups live. It is also home to a number of ancient sites, relics, religious buildings, etc. Rich in cultural resources and diverse in ethnic culture, the magnificent and beautiful Qilian Mountain is the mainstay of this national park, a natural ecological barrier in western China, an important water reservoir and a priority region for biodiversity conservation in the Yellow River watershed. The Qilian Mountain Cultural Circle, which unites nomadic ethnic people with shared love for the grassland, can be traced back to the Han Dynasty. Back then, there were four administrative counties here as Zhang Qian pioneered the famed "Silk Road" and helped his emperor expand the rule and the territory. Qilian Mountain National Park is a community of shared destiny and a concerto of "harmony and mutual support".

#### Guardians Deep in Qilian Mountain

#### Portugal: Sailing to a Sea of Green Forests

#### Damiao: An Ancient Village along the Silk Road

Daimiao Village under Xinglong Township of Gansu is hailed as a stronghold along the Silk Road with its 400 years' history. It is home to Wenfeng Academy, which was established in 1882 and one of the four academies of Jingyuan. It is also a cradle of revolutionaries in the Republic of China. Its exquisite architecture like drum tower, town god's temple and opera house; popular folk culture like Shaanxi Opera and fire ritual; beautiful sceneries like one-hundred-old pear garden, frozen forests, the nine turns of the Yellow River, the morning bell of ancient temple and blazing maple forests; all have attracted lots of tourists.

#### The Turtle City of Yongtai: A Military Stranglehold

The Turtle City of Yongtai in Jingtai County, Gansu, was built in 1607 AD. It is a rarely well-preserved city built in the Ming Dynasty, and used to be a vital military chokepoint in history, as traces of military facilities are still visible. It resembles a big turtle, thus named as turtle city. Its fame can be attributed to being the hometown of a famous general of the Qing Dynasty; and it is also one of the three primary schools intact since the Republic of China.
